### ORDER

As per G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Government have constituted a State Level Advisory Committee (SLAC) chaired by Chief Secretary for taking decision on establishing Integrated Solid Waste Management Plants in the State and related matters.

2. As per G.O read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above Government have taken a policy decision for the setting up of Waste-to-Energy (WtE) Plants at 7 sites in the State, one each in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Thrissur, Palakkadu, Kozhikode, Malappuram and Kannur districts on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) basis, in Public Private Partnership mode. KSIDC was designated as the nodal agency to set up the Waste to Energy plants in collaboration with the Concessionaire and local bodies, float the RFP, select the concessionaire and execute the concession agreement.

Amount to be quoted for power being generated in the plant was the criteria for submitting the bid.

- 3. As per G.O read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above Government have accorded sanction for the revised project structure with Tipping Fee as bidding criteria and approved the revised bidding documents. As per the directions of State Level Advisory Committee on waste management chaired by Chief Secretary, KSIDC has floated global tender for identifying suitable private implementing agencies for the development of Waste to Energy projects at Kollam, Kannur and Palakkad districts. In the circumstance that no bids were received for the Kollam project in the first and second tendering, as per the directions of State Level Advisory Committee on waste management, KSIDC retendered the project for the third time and Consortium lead by M/s Zonta Infratech Pvt Ltd based in Bangalore submitted bid for Kollam Project.
- 4. The State Level Advisory Committee on waste management as per the minutes read as 6<sup>th</sup> paper above has resolved to proceed with the evaluation of the bid received. The bid evaluation committee constituted as per GO read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above has evaluated the bid based on pre qualification criteria and minimum eligibility criteria detailed in the RFP document. The Technical Committee chaired by Principal Secretary Revenue reviewed the Technical Plan in detail. As the Consortium meets the minimum eligibility criteria and the Technical Evaluation Committee is satisfied with the technical plan submitted by the bidder, as per the minutes read as 7<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Bid Evaluation Committee has resolved that the consortium led by M/s Zonta Infratech Pvt. Ltd is technically qualified and recommended to open the financial bid submitted by the consortium led by M/s Zonta Infratech Pvt. Ltd.
- 5. As per the Financial Bid Submitted, the Tipping Fee quoted by the Consortium was Rs. 3,576/- (Rupees Three Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy Six). The Negotiation Committee constituted with Managing Director KSIDC as chairman has negotiated with the Consortium to bring down the tipping fee quoted in to a lower mutually agreeable rate. After two rounds of negotiation bidder has offered a revised tipping fee of Rs. 3450/- per tonne, subject to the condition that a confirmation on per capita based Viability Gap Fund of Rs. 45 Crore can be made available for the project as per SBM (Urban) guidelines.
- 6. As per the minutes read as 8<sup>th</sup> paper above, 33 <sup>rd</sup> meeting of SLAC on waste management chaired by Chief Secretary has resolved to approve the negotiated **Tipping fee of Rs. 3450/- per tonne**, offered by the consortium led by M/s Zonta Infratech Pvt. Ltd for Kollam Waste to Energy project. As per the letter read as 9<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Managing Director KSIDC has requested to accord sanction to the final tipping fee of Rs. 3450/- per tonne offered by the consortium lead by M/s Zonta Infratech Pvt Ltd with a confirmation on maximum per capita based VGF of Rs. 45 Crore as per SBM (Urban) guidelines, for the development of Integrated Solid Waste Management Project with a Waste to Energy plant of minimum 200 TPD capacity at Kureepuzha in Kollam district.
