ORDER

One among the major infrastructure projects of Local Self Government Department announced in the Budget Speech 2017-2018, to be implemented with the financial assistance from KIIFB is establishing 14 Septage Treatment Plants in the State, one in each district, for a total financial outlay of Rs.150Cr. As per the G.O. read as 1st paper above, Government have constituted IMPACT Kerala Ltd., a Special Purpose Vehicle for the implementation of various major infrastructure projects in Local Government Sector utilizing the financial assistance from KIIFB.

- 2. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Managing Director, IMPACT Kerala Ltd. has submitted a proposal for issuing administrative sanction for the setting up of Septage Treatment Plants in Local Self Government Institutions of Kerala for a total amount of Rs. 150 crore utilizing the financial assistance from KIIFB
- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail. Safe disposal of human excreta and disposal of waste water is highly essential for the Society for health reasons. The option available at present for disposal of excreta are either onsite or off-site sewerage systems. On-site sanitation system prevailing till date, in most of the towns, are individualistic system with inherent problems for collection & disposal of sludge and risks of contamination of ground water. Treatment plants specifically meant for septage treatment is an attractive option for safe disposal of

septage. The health hazards caused by dumping of septage in water bodies and open spaces will come to an end when septage treatment plants are become operational. Independent septage treatment plants are designed specifically for septage treatment and have seperate unit processes to handle both the liquid and solid portion of septage. The septage treatment plants provide a regional solution to septage management. Therefore it is essential to establish individual septage treatment plants in various Local Self Government Institutions in the State.

4. In the above circumstance Government are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the setting up of Septage Treatment Plants in various Local Self Government Institutions in the State for an amount of Rs. 150 crore by utilizing the financial assistance from KIIFB.
